**Minutes of the Extraordinary Parish Council Meeting held on
Thursday 6th April 2023 at 4.00 pm in the Fountaine Chapel**

1. To receive apologies for absence.

There were none.

Councillor McGuinn arrived at the meeting at 4.10 pm

Councillor Hill arrived at the meeting at 4.15 pm

2. To receive any declarations of interest under the Council's Code of Conduct

There were none.

3. To consider the following Planning Applications: (Any applications received by the clerk after publishing the agenda will be tabled at the meeting)

a. Reference C/50/58D Catchall Barn, Lauradale Lane, Linton, Skipton, North Yorkshire, BD23 6BE

Full planning permission for change of use of barn to office accommodation/secure storage; erection of four storage buildings to house further administration, welfare and workshop facilities and covered internal storage of shipping containers; and associated works to vehicular access, turning and parking areas at Catchall Barn, Lauradale Lane, Linton, Skipton, North Yorkshire, BD23 6BE

The application was discussed and the Chairman permitted members of the public to speak when a request to do so was made.

The feedback from Parishioners received since the last meeting was reviewed.

There were responses supportive of the business and its expansion given the employment diversity that it brings to the area and responses concerned that the development of the Catchall Barn site to enable this expansion will be detrimental to the vistas and biodiversity of the National Parks.

The consensus was found to be that a third of the feedback received was in support of the application and two thirds were against.

As the majority of the feedback received from Parishioners was not in favour of the planning application the Council agreed unanimously to write and object to this application as this was the view and wish of the parishioners.
