Minutes of the Extraordinary Parish Council Meeting held on Wednesday 3rd May 2023 at 7.30 pm in in the Anderton Memorial Institute, Lauradale Lane, Linton BD23 5HQ

1. To receive apologies for absence.

Apologies were received and accepted from Cllr McGuinn who was attending a meeting of the Gardner Trust.

2. To receive any declarations of interest under the Council's Code of Conduct

There were none.

3. To consider and respond to:

a. Yorkshire Dales National Park Authority new Local Plan – Consultation

There had been no development put forward for Linton and Linton Falls.

The Councillors agreed to submit comments regarding the developments below which it was agreed not to support: -

Threshfield Reference THR4 – not supported

The concerns raised were –

- i. the large number of planned dwellings
- ii. whether the current utilities system mainly sewerage would be able to cope with the increase in load
- iii. the impact of such an increase of population on the local infrastructure e.g schools, doctors surgery etc

Grassington Reference GRA1 – not supported

The concerns raised were –

- i. the access to the proposed dwellings
- ii. the development eroding the Dales landscape
- iii. the location was not infill in a residential area of the village

Cracoe References CRA1, CRA2 and CRA4 – not supported

The concerns raised were –

- i. the visual impact on the landscape
- ii. the scale of CRA2
- iii. the locations were not infill in a residential area of the village

- b. **DLUHC Consultation On Infrastructure Levy**
The Councillors declined to comment on this item.
